- Each family will gain a better understanding of the stages of their child's development and learn appropriate ways in which to foster their child's continued development.

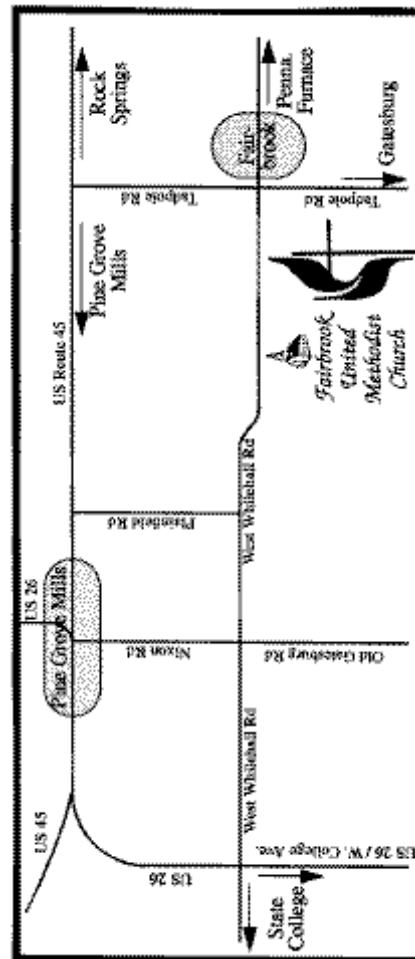
Our Vision

We envision a preschool in which children can just be children—free from the pressures and stresses of our society and where they have time to play, imagine, explore, learn and dream without being rushed.

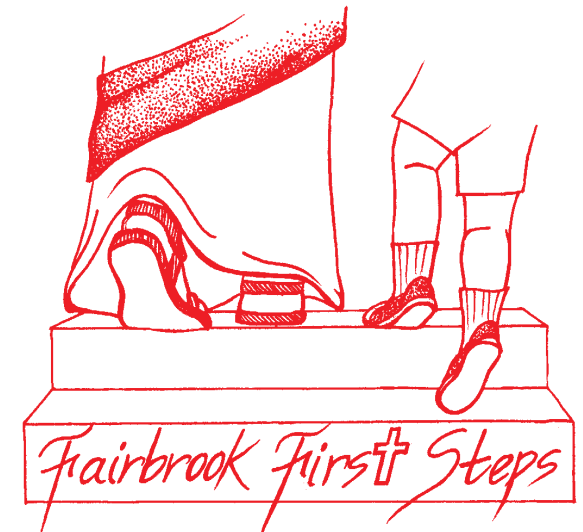

Developmental Curriculum

The Fairbrook First Steps Christian Preschool provides a stimulating social and educational environment for preschool children ages 3 and 4.



The experienced teachers at Fairbrook First Steps are committed to working with each child developmentally, socially, academically, and spiritually, while incorporating and respecting each child's individual ideas, preferences, abilities and interests.

Our curriculum is designed to assess and promote development in the following areas:

- **Social/Emotional**
- **Physical - Gross Motor and Fine Motor**
- **Cognitive**
- **Language and Literacy**

Growth and learning in these areas will occur through hands-on learning and exploration, interaction at activity centers, indoor and outdoor free play, and large and small group activities - all within a literature-rich environment. Christian education will be an integral part of the daily classroom routines and activities.



Each class is taught by two certified teachers with the help of parent volunteers, and is limited to 18 students.

Children in the preschool class must turn 3 on or before October 31st.

We suggest that students attend all three days, however there will be a limited number of spaces available for families that desire to have their child attend only two days per week.

School Calendar

Fairbrook First Steps Christian Preschool will begin classes in September and end the last week of May. The preschool will follow the holiday and vacation schedule of the State College Area School District calendar during the regular school year.

Tuition costs for the preschool are paid monthly.

The cost for the two-day preschool option is **\$135 per month.**
The cost for the three-day preschool option is **\$180 per month.**
